Maryland State Department of Education: \$50

Maryland DOE is offering 1 credit hour per 6 Let's Talk 2e Educator Conference sessions for a

total of 2 potential credits. In order to receive credits, educators must complete watching each session for which they are requesting credits and pass the attendant quiz with at least an 8/10 score, then submit a completed journal about the sessions, and an annotated bibliography.
